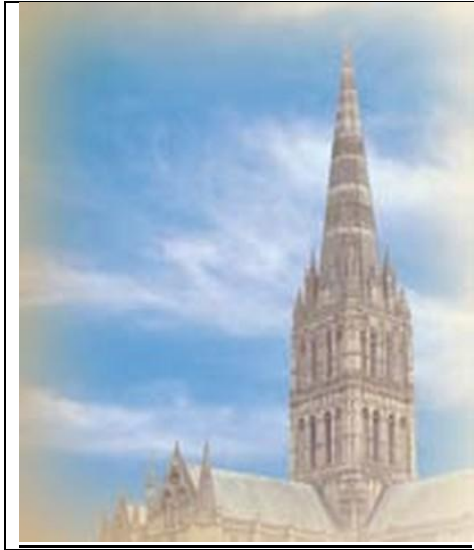


CASTING CALL FOR THIS YEARS CHRISTMAS PAGEANT; **all ages!**

Characters etc.:

Narrator; (contemporary dress at lectern or storyteller dress on stage)

Marie or Ian; 12 to 14 years old (dressed in peasant clothing) the most lines

Andrew or Anna; 10 to 12 years old (dressed in peasant clothing) the most lines

Money Changer; Old, gruff, greedy, can be male or female (8 lines- can be read)

Innkeeper; Selfish, loud, worldly, can be male or female teen or adult. (5 lines)

Town Crier; two lines

1-3 scripture readers for the nativity section: male or female older teen or adult.

King or Queen; Proud, noble, eloquent, a little full of himself or herself.

Chorus; (the chorus forms the crowd of people in the town and the congregation at the cathedral.)
Pheasants, Merchants and Lords and Ladies. All ages.

Nativity Scene characters. (Younger children – no lines) Mary, Joseph, Shepherds, lambs, Magi, Angels.
(Can be members of the Chorus taking two parts)

Minor but important roles!!!! Old woman in the snow (no lines) Herald (four lines), 1 Merchant (one line), 2 Nobel people (one line) ,3 Congregation(one line) (all are also a part of the Chorus) Bell Ringer (no lines)

Costume and Prop Finders, Designers and Builders, Videographer, Any one with creative talents!

Sunday November 27 –. 9:30 Children begin practice of Nativity part of the pageant in God's Garden by helping to put our the outdoor nativity. Please attend with your children in outdoor attire at 9:30 am

-11:00 Teens and Adults begin Reading through script and choosing costumes

Sunday December 4 9:30 Children practice of Nativity part of the pageant and songs in God's Garden classroom

11:00 Teens and Adults Walk through pageant with scripts and songs

Sunday December 11 9:30 Children practice of Nativity part of the pageant and song in God's Garden classroom

11:00 Teens and Adults and children run though parts in costumes, with props and music.
