2. The size must be HALF of a piece of Bristol board. It could be cut in a triangle or rectangle or circle or cloud or any other shape.
3. Write your name (the artist's name) on the bottom of the picture with your age. All ages welcome.
4. It must be completed in 40 days (That's how long LENT is.) **Due date "NO LATER THAN MARCH 27th** so it can be hung in the gallery (on the walls) in the church before HOLY WEEK.
5. Bring it to the church office Tues, Wed. or Thursday or bring it to my house.

	<u>Picture</u> <u>Please read the</u> <u>Scripture</u>	<u>The Story behind the Picture and a suggestion for the picture.</u>
1	Palms Matthew 21:1-11 Luke 19: 28-36	Long thin leaves on a stem; what the people laid on the ground to welcome Jesus to Jerusalem.
2	Donkey John 12:12-15	A donkey; Jesus rode on a donkey into Jerusalem.
3	bread and wine Luke 22:17-20 Mark 14:22-25	Bread and wine ;Jesus told his disciples to remember him when they ate bread and drank wine at the last supper.
4	washing feet John 13:3-10	A big bowl of water with a towel and feet in it.: Jesus washed the disciples feet to show that they should also serve others and not expect to be served if they wanted to follow Him.
5	30 pieces of silver Matthew 26:14-16	A bag of coins; What the leaders paid Judas to show them where Jesus was so they could arrest him.
6	Garden of Gethsemane Mark 14:32-42	Praying hands in a garden of flowers; Jesus prayed in the Garden to make sure he was doing the right thing. This is where Judas led the soldiers to capture Jesus.
7	The Sword John 18:10-11	Sword: Peter, one of Jesus Disciples, drew his sword to defend Jesus and cut off one of his attackers ears. Jesus healed the ear and went quietly with the soldiers
8	The Rooster Luke 22:54-62 Mark 14:66-72	Jesus foretold that Peter would say he did not know Jesus three times before the rooster crowed. He was right but forgave Peter.
9	Crown of Thorns Matthew 27:27-28	Prickly Crown of Thorns; Cruel soldiers placed it on Jesus head because they did not believe He was a real king.
10	The Crucifixion Luke 23:32-34	Large wooden Cross; Where they hung Jesus to die.
11	sour wine on a sponge Mark:15:23 John 19: 28-30	Sponge on a long stick dripping with red wine; When Jesus said he was thirsty, the soldiers gave him sour wine in a sponge.
12	The Tomb and burial shroud Matthew 28:1-2 John 20:1-7	After Jesus died on the cross, He was wrapped in lined and placed in a tomb. (a big cave) with a large round stone for a door.
13	Resurrection and Ascension Luke 24:1-5 and 24:50	Empty tomb or Jesus shining brightly as he rose to Heaven ! On Easter Morning Jesus was alive! He had risen and was no longer in the tomb. Jesus ascended into heaven and proved that there was life after death. This is why we celebrate EASTER !
